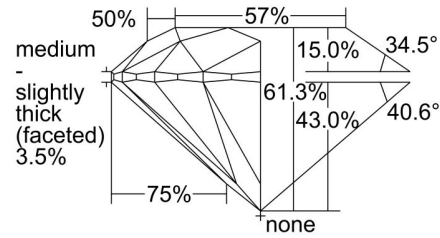

Profile to actual proportions

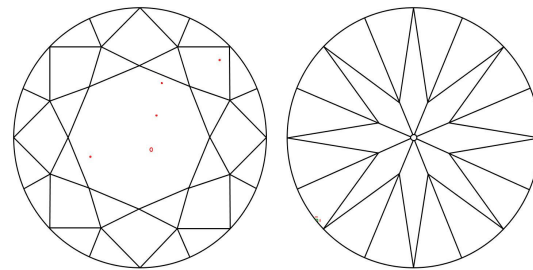
