

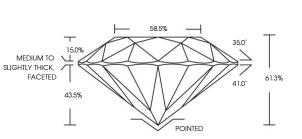

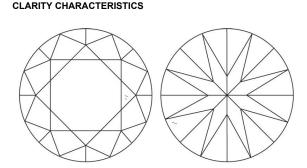

The laboratory grown diamond described in this Report (Report) has been graded, tested, analyzed, examined and/or inscribed by International Gemological Institute (1.G.I.). A laboratory grown diamond is one that has essentially the same chemical, physical and optical properties as a mined diamond, with the exception of being grown by man (a manufactured product). This is a manufactured (man-made) diamond produced by CVD (chemical vapor deposition) or by HPHT (high pressure high temperature) growth processes and may include post-growth treatments to alter the color. I.G.I. employs and utilizes those techniques and equipment currently available to LG.I., including, without limitation, 10X magnification, corrected triplet loupe, binocular microscope, master color comparison stones, non-contact-optical measuring device, Spectraphotometer and such other instruments and/or processes as deemed appropriate by I.G.I. In the case where diamond melee is set in Spectraphotometer and such other instruments a mounting, a random testing procedure, regarding the diamonds being of natural or laboratory created origin will be performed.
