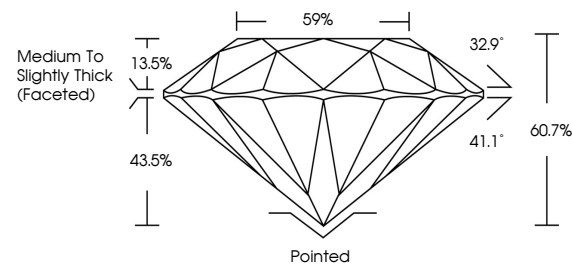

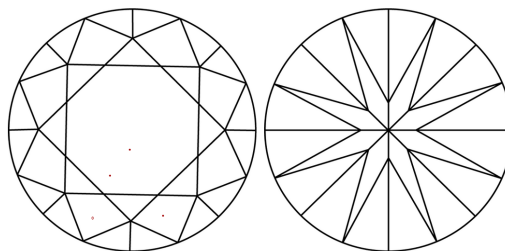

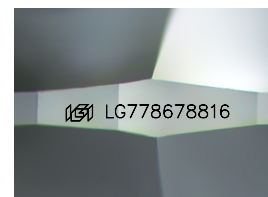


CLARITY CHARACTERISTICS

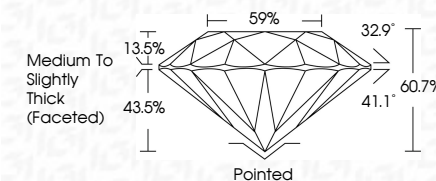
