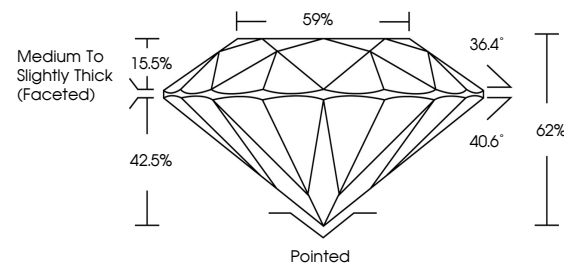

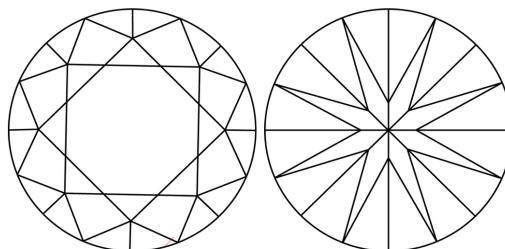

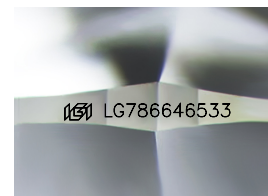


CLARITY CHARACTERISTICS

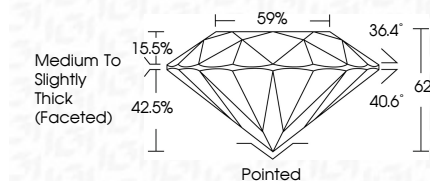
